The council met with the Bishop to discuss the possibility of a Vicar for Abiding Peace.

The council will meet with the candidate at the end of July to discuss the position and to see if the situation will work.

If the council and candidate decide to go forward, the candidate will be at our worship service on August 7th to lead our service and we will have a congregational meeting on August 14th to finalize the proposed contract.

This is not a normal call process for a pastor and is a bit too complicated to go over the position in a newsletter article, so I encourage you to attend the worship service on August 7th to meet the candidate and the congregational meeting on August 14th to go over the proposed contract. If for some reason the candidate and / or council decides not to go forward, both August dates mentioned will be canceled.

This is a very quick process and being done on a very short notice, but in this case time is of the essence. I will attempt to answer any questions our members have on these dates.

We had an elected member of council resign due to a change in work requirements (not being able to attend our meetings). I urge you to consider being a member of your Church Council. We usually meet the third Tuesday of the month. Want to see what we do? Feel free to come to our next meeting and observe what we do. Our meetings are open to all.
